Shift to urbanization boosts consumer spending.

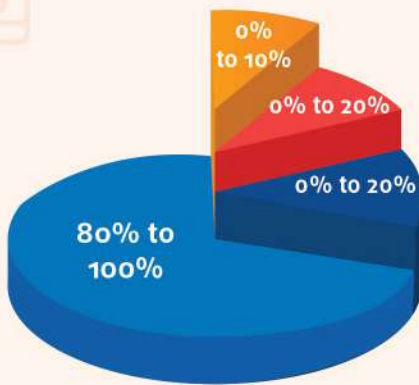


Online shopping and accessibility lead to higher consumption
